The camp’s electrical wiring is the original from time of buying the property. Some wires have lost all insulation with sections reconnected inadequately. Many of the sections are not encased as required by current code. It is dangerous for personal

shocks and fires. The wiring inside the building is also in disrepair. All of this causes electricity losses and higher bills.
